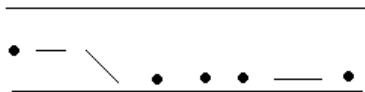

- e) We saw Paul yesterday (Talking about who we saw yesterday)

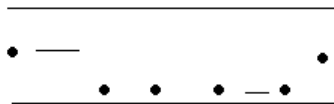

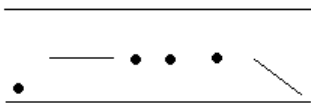

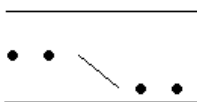
